

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION ON NON-CONSIDERATION OF MATERIAL ADVERSE EVENTS IN THE INVESTMENT DECISIONS OF MEDVIDA PARTNERS DE SEGUROS Y REASEGUROS, S.A. (SOCIEDAD UNIPERSONAL)

Regulation (EU) 2019/2088 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 November 2019 on sustainability disclosures in the financial services sector, in its Article 4, requires financial market participants to publish on their websites, a Statement on whether or not major adverse impacts on sustainability-related investment decisions are taken into consideration at entity level (*).

MEDVIDA PARTNERS de Seguros y Reaseguros, S.A. (Sociedad Unipersonal), as a company participating in the financial market, hereby states the following in compliance with the aforementioned article 4:

In accordance with the legal requirements derived from the Disclosure Regulation and the technical implementing rules (RTS), it has decided not to take into account the adverse impacts of investment decisions on sustainability factors for the time being, as, based on the principle of proportionality and taking into consideration the existing legal requirements, the size of the organisation, as well as the target market at which they are aimed, it has been considered that the impact of taking them into account at the present time would be disproportionate. MEDVIDA PARTNERS de Seguros y Reaseguros, S.A. (Sociedad Unipersonal) will evaluate this decision in the medium or long term through a periodic review. This will take into account factors such as the evolution and strategy of the Company, the regulations to be enacted, the development of the industry and market practices in relation to this matter.

(*) "Major adverse impacts" should be understood as those events in investment advice and decisions that have a negative impact on sustainability factors.

"Sustainability factors": as "any information related to environmental and social issues, as well as to personnel, respect for human rights and the fight against corruption and bribery".
